Council Report

Brief History and Statutory Background

The Institute of Designers in Ireland (IDI) is the professional body representing the interests of Irish designers. Its members run the Institute on a voluntary basis with the assistance of an Executive Officer, in full employment. There are three basic organisational units, namely Officers, Council and Committees.

Officers:

The Officers consist of three presidential members (current president, immediate past-president and president-elect), the honorary treasurer, honorary secretary and executive officer. Officers' meetings take place on a monthly basis a week prior to Council meetings. Additional meetings are held when necessary.

Council:

Council consists of the Officers and two representatives (when possible) from each section, elected on an annual basis. Council meets once a month to discuss the Institutes on-going activities and initiatives.

Committees:

A number of Committees are formed to address and implement the Institutes initiatives and policies or to undertake specific tasks.

The IDI is recognised at National, European and International levels as the representative body of the design profession in Ireland.

We welcome members from a broad range of design disciplines. Our Council was originally appointed in 1972 and is subsequently reappointed by our membership for 1-year periods.

Membership of the Institute of Designers is open to all students, graduates and professionals who can satisfy the entry requirements.

Currently there are over 300 members from a wide range of disciplines, including graphic design, product design, interior design, fashion and textile design as well as design management and those involved in design education.

All applicants for Membership of the Institute shall be citizens of Ireland or be resident in Ireland.

To ensure that Membership remains meaningful, the Institute lays down a Code of Professional Conduct, observance of which is a condition of Membership.
